SAFETY REPORT:

Chief Jacobs read his report. The next safety committee meeting will take place on November 29, 2016 at 7:30 PM. Chief commends the actions of the members who responded to the fire on October 31st in rough weather conditions in a remote area.

Planning Group Workshop:

Chief Carnes gave an overview of the topics discussed, which included a presentation from General Fire, finalizing the 2016 amended budget, the RFP for moving a generator and disposition of the air unit. The next meeting is scheduled for November 30, 2016, 6:00 PM at Station 91

Consider EMS Levy Resolution #213-11012016:

Chief Carnes explained that this is the EMS property tax levy.

Consider EMS Levy Substantial Need Resolution #214-11012016:

Chief Carnes explained that this resolution is needed to declare substantial need for the EMS levy. **Motion by Commissioner Gianatasio** to adopt resolutions #213-11012016 and #214-11012016, **seconded by Taggart**. **Motion passed** unanimously.

Consider General Levy Resolution #215-11012016:

Chief Carnes explained that this is the General Fund property tax levy.

Consider General Levy Resolution #216-11012016:

Chief Carnes explained that this resolution is needed to declare substantial need for the General Fund levy. **Motion by Commissioner Taggart** to adopt resolutions #215-11012016 and #216-11012016, seconded by Gianatasio. Motion passed unanimously.

FY2017 Draft Budget:

Chief Carnes explained that this budget has no changes since the last meeting. Motion by Commissioner Petty to approve the FY2017 Draft Budget, seconded by Taggart. Motion passed unanimously.

Lexipol Proposal:

Chief Swinhart offered to find out if any kind of discount would be available to East County based on Camas' subscription and the administrative merger. Commissioner Martin would like an updated quote and possibly a presentation from Lexipol on their services.

Bias Software Proposal:

The commissioners discussed the proposed benefits of the software. Motion by Commissioner Taggart to purchase the Bias Hosted Software, seconded by Berg. Motion passed unanimously.

Consider 2017 COLA for Part-Time Firefighters:

Chief Carnes explained that this increase would be applied only to the base pay of the firefighters. **Motion by Commissioner Berg** to approve the 2017 COLA for Part-Time Firefighters, **seconded by Petty**. **Motion passed** unanimously.

Chief Carnes detailed plans for the Holiday Dinner.

Petty Cash Account:

2017 EMS LEVY BUDGET EAST COUNTY FIRE & RESCUE RESOLUTION NO. 217-1152016

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF EAST COUNTY FIRE & RESCUE

- 1. That the attached hereto Exhibit "A" (by this reference made a part of this resolution) be and hereby is adopted as the EMS Levy budget of East County Fire & Rescue for the calendar year 2017.
 - A. The purpose of the EMS Levy Budget is to account for Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Levy funds that are "passed through" East County Fire & Rescue to the City of Camas via their EMS fund 6620.
 - **B.** Funds for this budget are obtained from Tax Revenue received via Levy 6291311104 East County Fire/Rescue EMS.
 - C. The collection and transfer of these funds is done in accordance with a service agreement for the Emergency Medical Transport Services Program. Participants in this agreement include East County Fire and Rescue, the City of Camas, and the City of Washougal.
- 2. That one copy of this resolution together with Exhibit "A" be delivered to each of the following:

Clark County Board of Commissioners, Auditor's, Treasurer's, and Assessor's office.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF WARRANTS

Background: RCW 52.16.050 authorizes a fire protection district to issue its own warrants under the following conditions:

- 1. The District has had an annual operating budget of greater than two hundred fifty thousand dollars and under five million dollars in each of the preceding three years.
- 2. The County Treasurer agrees to the procedure.

The Board finds that the conditions have been complied with and that it is in the best interests of the District that the District begin issuing its own warrants.

The Administrative Specialist serves as the District Auditing Officer.

Resolution: NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of East County Fire & Rescue:

- 1. Adopts the following Warrant Issuance Policy:
 - 1.1. The Board of the District hereby authorizes the Clark County Treasurer to pay all warrants electronically submitted, via one general certificate to the Clark County Treasurer, which will specify the fund number on which the warrants shall be drawn, date, warrant number and amount; and
 - 1.2. The Accounting Assistant shall then issue the warrants specified in the general certificate in accordance with the following procedures:
 - 1.2.1. The Accounting Assistant shall prepare a warrant for each claim which will be coded according to the Washington State Business Accounting and Reporting System ("BARS") for Fire Districts.
 - 1.2.2. Each warrant shall bear the signature of at least two authorized individuals. Routine operating expenses up to Ten Thousand dollars (\$10,000) and payroll benefit claims of any amount may be approved by the Deputy Chief and Auditing Officer. Any warrants in excess of Ten Thousand dollars (\$10,000) must be pre-audited and signed by the Chair of the Board and either the Deputy Chief or the Auditing Officer.
 - **1.2.3.** If either the Deputy Chief or Auditing Officer is not available, the Chair of the Board shall sign as the second signature.
 - **1.2.4.** If the Chair of the Board is not available, the Vice Chair shall sign warrant(s). If the Chair of the Board and Vice Chair are not available, any other Board member shall sign warrant(s).
 - **1.2.5.** The Deputy Chief, Auditing Officer and Commissioners shall be bonded for no less than Fifty Thousand dollars (\$50,000), respectively, to assure the faithful discharge of their duties.

- **1.2.6.** The Accounting Assistant shall submit to the Board prior to its regular monthly meetings a full and complete report of all claims paid pursuant to this Resolution.
- 1.2.7. The Board shall review all claims and approve them at its regular monthly meetings.
- **1.2.8.** Board approval shall be documented by the signing the consent agenda.
- 1.2.9. If the Board disapproves any claim, the Deputy Chief and Auditing Officer will recognize the claim as a receivable of the District and will pursue collection diligently until the amount is either collected or the Board is satisfied and approves the claim.
- 2. This Policy shall become effective on January 1, 2017.
