SCBA Proposal

Station 93 Heat Pump

One of the heat pump units at station 93 is out of service, unfortunately it needs a new compressor. Fortunately there is a 5 ton system that will support the heating/cooling needs of the facility and would require ducting work to connect the 2 systems. The estimated cost of this repair is \$1700 plus tax.

We did request quotes from Miller's Heating for pricing on a new heat pump, and a new compressorthose costs were communicated to the Commissioners via email.

Motion by Commissioner Petty to approve heat pump maintenance at Station 93, seconded by Commissioner Martin. Motion passed unanimously.
