FIRE DISTRICT BUSINESS:

Grove Field Fire System Upgrade:

Damon Webster presented a proposal to the board that involves the Port Airport building a water line that ties into Station 91's existing fireline in order to supply newly updated fire suppression systems at the airport. Discussion included benefits to the port, potential permitting, financial ramifications and suppression system compatibility. The board would like to consult with their attorney prior to issuing a decision.

Lexipol:

Chief Carnes reiterated the meeting date of the Policy Update workshop scheduled for April 27th, 2017, 6:30 PM at station 91. This item will remain tabled until further notice.

Tuition Reimbursement Proposal:

Chief Carnes provided a brief overview of the previously proposed tuition reimbursement plan for prospective interns.
