<u>Update on Surplus Vehicle</u> Nothing new to report.

#### Station 95

Per the Boards direction at the last meeting on February 17, 2020, Chief Carnes contacted the district's attorney to see what other options we might have moving forward. The options discussed with the district's attorney, were the possibility to lease Station 95 to the City of Washougal and if we did, address insurance costs, and would it be considered gifting if ECFR paid the property taxes on the neighbor's property. The district's attorney said we can lease Station 95 to the City of Washougal and ECFR should insure the building. Also, we could possibly pay the neighbor's property taxes for the purposes of making the sale. Chief Carnes stated he tried to contact the property owners via phone on two occasions and has left a voicemail each time and there has been no response from the neighbors. The Board's consensus is to lease Station 95 for the costs associated with the building. Chief Carnes will pursue an updated PSA with the City of Washougal to lease Station 95 until we can file the documents in November 2020 to clear the title.

#### Affirmation Letter for Walmart Foundation Grant Application

Walmart requires a signed affirmation letter to submit our application for a grant. Chairperson Martin will sign the letter.

#### Request from the University of Washington

The University of Washington contacted Chief Carnes via email to see if ECFR would partner with them to place a solar panel powered machine on the district's property to monitor seismic activity of Silver Star Mountain, this would be at no cost to the district. Chief Carnes asked the board if they would be interested in him gathering more information on the proposed partnership of the seismic activity monitor. The board would like Chief Carnes to gather more information.

#### CALL TO ORDER: 14:01

Chairperson Martha Martin called the meeting to order for the Strategic Planning/Shared Services Committee.

Chief Carnes began the meeting by letting those in attendance know Michelle Mazzola would not be available for the conference call today.

Chief Carnes handed out and discussed an ECFR Bonds sheet that showed the balances currently owed on ECFR's two bonds. The 2012 Bond refinanced two existing bonds and the 2007A Bond was a second bond for the building of Station 91.

Chief Carnes handed out the Program Management outline to the commissioners that shows the delegation of duties and responsibilities.

Chief Carnes said he communicated with Chief Swinhart about the five questions ECFR asked in regards to the upcoming EMS Levy and a deadline of April 1, 2020 has been set to receive the information from the CWFD. Commissioner Seeds stated the data will need to be in a spreadsheet.

Chief Carnes said he spoke with North Country EMS in regards to their cost per call and North Country EMS charges \$2,100.00 per call. North Country is funded by a 10 year regular property tax levy at .50 per 1,000. They do run an excess levy every 3 to 5 years based on their finances. North Country EMS bills the insurance company, and does not bill the tax payer.

Chief Carnes asked to schedule station tours of Station 93 and Station 94. The date for station tours was set for April 8, 2020 at 2:00 PM during the next Strategic Planning Meeting.

Chief Carnes handed out the 2019 Fire District Annual Report and Chief Carnes said Linda Durrett has uploaded the report to the District's website.

Commissioner Petty discussed the overall call volume for January and February this year, as the overall calls are up 70% - 20% ECFR's and 50% into the city. She would like to see more numbers at the regular board meetings and track the percentages.

Captain Troutman proposed that the Board consider using the Training Room at Station 91 for the PT area and move the Regular Board Meetings to Station 93 after painting and replacing the carpet at Station 93 as this is a more affordable option than building a wall in the bay area at Station 91 for the PT area. The Board will keep this proposal in mind during the Station Tours on April 8, 2020.

Firefighter VanNess commented on the exposure to PFOA's.
