- We have had some challenges in staffing stations lately. Sickness and FMLA have been the big contributors.
- We have not received any new applications for Fire Chief as of today. The application window closes on Monday, June 27.
- We had some mechanical issues with Squad 91 on Saturday, May 21. It had to be towed to the
 dealership and repaired. The repairs were covered by warranty. We are also working with Ford
 Motor Company to see if they will reimburse the tow costs.
- Some of the ECFR crews participated in rope rescue MCO drills at the "Pot Holes" in Camas this past week.
- I attended a Clark County Fire Chiefs meeting on Thursday, June 2. Topics of discussion were countywide mutual aid agreements, DNR wild fire mutual aid agreements, and July 4 response plans throughout the county. There was discussion on firefighter staffing issues throughout the county. CRESA and AMR are also having staffing issues. The main issues for all three entities is the lack of qualified applicants.
